Nearly 7 years ago, the board of directors launched the Gather Campaign to build a center for dining, hospitality, community, and fellowship that could meet the needs of our growing population.

In 2020, the economic uncertainty brought on by the Covid pandemic led us to end the Gather Campaign early. We used committed campaign funds to build as much of the new center as possible. It is already making a difference. But now, post-Covid, it is clear that the partial building is still not enough.
